

EARNED INCOME STATEMENT

Please be aware that when a Resident is eligible for Medicaid, this facility will be due any earned income the Resident receives (i.e. Social Security and/or pension), beginning the month that the Resident begins to receive Medicaid benefits. This is a condition of the Medicaid allowance and not a facility policy.

Should a Resident require Medicaid in order to finance his or her placement, the facility will be happy to assist in filing for assistance. Proof of citizenship or legal residency in the U.S. and the last three years of any financial information (i.e. bank statements, statements of life insurance, etc.) are required for Medicaid assistance, and representative assumes the responsibility of supplying this and any other information requested by the Medicaid office to the facility. Should the representative wish to file for Medicaid independently, or file through the use of a private attorney, the representative must notify the facility of the date that Medicaid will begin payment and be aware that the facility will be due any earned income for that month and subsequent months at that time.

The representative agrees to meet with Resident Accounts Representative to review these conditions at the time of admission.
